**Subject: - Himachal Pradesh Government Plan for Mobile Phones**

Sir,

I have been directed to refer to this office letter no. DIT-F(35)-3/2006-2942-3118 dated 06.10.2006 on the above mentioned subject and to say that it has been decided to allow 2900 connections for the first Closed User Group (CUG) as per the breakup given in **Annexure-A** to this letter. These numbers have been worked out after considering number of Class I to III employees (as per Employees' Census dated 31.03.05 conducted by Economics & Statistics Department) in conjunction with functional requirement. The Head of Department concerned shall further devise norms for allowing membership of the first CUG or authorize individual applicants for availing this membership. BSNL shall entertain an application only on the basis of such an authorization or norms issued by the concerned Head of Department. For instance, the Engineer-in-Chief PWD may decide that all officers to the rank of Assistant Engineer and above (working or retired) are permitted to subscribe to the first CUG. He would also give Telecom

District-wise breakup (Shimla, Solan, Mandi, Kullu, Hamirpur and Dharamshala) of the total number earmarked for PWD. The competent authorities in Telecom Districts can then issue connections in the first CUG for the officers of specified rank up to the limit for that Telecom District on first-come-first-serve basis. As an alternative, the Head of Department may authorize an officer in his office to give individual-wise authorization.

Similarly, 1100 numbers are being kept for Public Sector Undertakings and other Autonomous Bodies as per breakup given in **Annexure-B**. Similar procedure for authorization as above shall be followed in this case also. If the numbers earmarked for a particular department/ organization are not utilized within a reasonable period (say 4-5 months) and there is a demand for additional allocation in another department/ organization re-allocation of numbers will be got done and an amended break-up will be issued.

It is clarified that no such restriction currently exists in the second CUG started after 20.10.2006.
