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You may recall vide letter no. IT-F (10)-3/2004 dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2005, decision of the State Government to set up Integrated Community Service Centres down to tehsil / sub-tehsil level had been conveyed to all the Deputy Commissioners. This Project, taken up on pilot basis with the name SUGAM in Shimla District and funded by UNDP & NISG, is nearing completion. All Deputy Commissioners have taken an excellent initiative to provide citizen centric services (like Vehicle Registration, Issuance of Driving Licence, Computerised of Land Records, e-Praman etc.) under a single roof at sub-divisional level. **However, these centres are currently known by different names such as *Pehal, Suvidha, Lokmitra* etc. leading to non-standardization and lack of brand image and recognition and actual services being provided vary from one place to another.** In addition to this, as already conveyed vide letter no. DIT(CSCs)20/2005-11-6921 dated 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2007; 3361 Community Service Centres (CSC) are being set up at Panchayat / Village level (one for every 6 census villages) in Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode.

**While finalising RFP for CSC Projected, it has been decided by the Government that all the centers set up at District / Sub-division / Tehsil / Sub-tehsil level shall be subsumed under a common brand name *Sugam* with an identical logo and common sign board and those at the Panchayat / Village level shall be christened *Gram Sugam*.** The name *Sugam* highlights easy accessibility to efficient citizen related services for citizens in a transparent and time-bound manner. Copy of the logo (**Annexure-I**) and list of services (**Annexure-II**) to be provided under *Sugam* located at various levels of administrative hierarchy are being enclosed herewith this letter. **Software applications for most of these services have been finalised and a *Sugam* Portal for tracking receipts at various *Sugam* Centres is also ready.** Each *Sugam* / *Gram Sugam*

center will also be given a unique code that will be helpful in standardising the applications and facilitating proper reporting and referencing. The coding scheme is at **Annexure-III**.

I hope that site preparation for these centres at District / Sub-division / Tehsil / Sub-tehsil levels in your district has been completed as per letter no. IT-F (10)-3/2004 dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2005 referred to above. You are also aware that the Department of Information Technology has pooled resources from various departments / organisations and also procured computer hardware at such aggressive rates that all these centres have sufficient computers and accessories for running the citizen centric services listed in **Annexure-II**. Moreover, IT Department has also provided additional hardware like computers, servers, touch-screen kiosks, printers etc., besides hardware for backend computerisation of various line departments. If a shortfall is still felt on this account or for improving civil / electrical infrastructure at site, you may approach the Department of Information Technology. **While these over-the-counter services are being offered as of now, this Project also envisages submission of applications at *Sugam* centres closest to the place of residence of citizen (irrespective of administrative level at which the job can be got done) and delivery of services at the doorstep.** For this purpose, a role based workflow application is under preparation.

**You are, therefore, requested to brand these e-Governance Centres as *Sugam*, for which glow sign board and other relevant display board can be provided to you after dimensions (size and shape) are conveyed to the Department of Information Technology.** Detailed guidelines for making these *Sugam* Centres fully operational are being sent separately.
